Bertha Eaker Robison Parker, a resident of Elder Care of Marble Hill, MO died on September 14, 2005 at the age of 94 years.

Mrs. Parker was born Bertha Mae Eaker, November 10, 1910 at Lutesville, MO the daughter of Montgomery and Clara Peter Lambert Eaker. She was preceded in death by two sisters; Mildred Eaker Bragg and Alpha Eaker Groseclose, one brother, Homer Eaker and a half brother Robert Lambert.

Mrs. Parker was married April 15, 1932 to her first husband Dewey Hampton Robison in Lutesville, MO. At the time of their marriage, Mr. Robison was the Bollinger County Treasurer, he preceded her in death on March 15, 1973 in

Cape Girardeau, MO where they were then residing; having returned several years prior from St. Louis, MO where they had resided since 1941.

Before and after her marriage to Mr. Robison, she taught at several one-room schools in the area; Sylvan, Clubb Creek, Hickory Grove, and Pecan Grove before moving to St. Louis.

She was married to her second husband, Estel Parker in 1977 while residing in Advance, MO; he preceded her in death in 1987.

In 1993 she moved from Advance to Golden, CO to be closer to her son. She returned to Marble Hill in 2000 residing at the El Nathan Home until 2004 when she moved to Elder Care.

Survivors include; one son Benjamin H. (Carol) Robison of Arvada, CO, three grandchildren, Nancy (Tom) Jones of Greeley, CO, Rebecca (Florian) Baltoi of Tempe, Arizona, and John (Deanna) Robison of Colorado Springs, CO and seven great-grandchildren; Shannon and Eric Jones, Daniel and Paul Baltoi, and Josiah, Hannah and Michaela Robison.
