Charles Henry Jordon passed away at 10:10 AM on June 12, 2021.

He was born on June 22, 1934 to Trentis and Lydia Muster Jordon. He married M. Fae Green Jordon on June 18, 1955 at Patton Presbyterian Church.

Charles quit school after finishing the 6th grade to help support his family. At the age of 15, he started working at his father's gas station. When he turned 16 he went to work at the Handle factory in Jackson, he then went into the United States Air Force for four years and received an honorable discharge. After the Air Force he moved his family back to Missouri and started working for Hill-Behan lumber Company in 1959 and retired after 41 years.

In 2002 he started working at Hickory Hills Apartments for 5 years doing maintenance work. On June 18, 2021 Charles and Fae would have been married for 66 years and on June 22, 2021 he would have been 87 years old. He and Fae are members of the Cottage of Grace General Baptist Church.
