Leola Bernadetta Tenholder, age 82, of Leopold, MO died Monday, April 26, 2004 at Saint Francis Medical Center in Cape Girardeau.

She was born September 20, 1921 at Leopold, daughter of Martin P. and Johannah A. Vandeven Tenholder.

Ms. Tenholder earned her nursing diploma in 1946; from DePaul University she received her bachelor's and her master's degree. She worked for St. Catherine Hospital in East Chicago, Indiana as an Assistant Administrator from 1958 to 1961; St. Mary's Hospital in Superior, Wisconsin, as an Assistant

Administrator from 1961 to 1963; in 1963 she returned to St. Catherine Hospital in East Chicago and worked as an Administrator from 1963 to 1969; from 1969 to 1970 she worked for St. Mary's Hospital in East Saint Louis, IL as an Assistant Administrator; in 1970 to 1972 she worked for St. Anne's Hospital in Chicago, IL as an Assistant Administrator; from 1972 to 1974 she worked for St. Elizabeth Hospital in Chicago, IL as an Administrator; from 1974 to 1980 she worked for the Shriners Children's Hospital in Portland, Oregon; she then moved to Oak Park, IL where she worked for the Oak Park Hospital as an Assistant Executive Director from 1980 to 1986. She retired from Bond's Nursing Home in Marble Hill where she was the Director of Nursing. She was a member of the Indiana Hospital Association from 1963 to 1967; the Fellow of American College of Hospital Administrators, a member of St. John, Apostle and Evangelist Church in Leopold, Legion of Mary Auxiliary, the Ladies Sodality, and a Red Cross volunteer.

Survivors include four sisters Agatha Debrock and Juliana Elfrink both of Leopold, Rosalia Elfrink of Belleville, IL, Mary F. Vandeven of Marble Hill, and several nieces and nephews.

Preceding her in death were her parents and one brother.
