Leroy Lukefahr, 87, of Leopold, MO passed away on Wednesday, October 08, 2025 at the StoneBridge Marble Hill facility.

He was born June 01, 1938 in Burfordville, MO to the late Pervis and Beulah Haupt Lukefahr. He and Bonnie West were married on June 16, 1961 in Hopewell, VA.

Leroy grew up on the family farm and graduated from Lutesville High School in 1957. Upon graduation he joined the National Guard then the Army in 1958. He was honorably discharged in 1960.
