Patsy Lou Dixon Sharrock was born July 5, 1940 at the family home in Sedgewickville, Missouri to Sadie Seabaugh Dixon and William Grant Dixon. Patsy was their fourth child of five, and third daughter. She was preceded by her parents, her brother JR Dixon, and her husband. Surviving her are two sisters, Ora Dean Bennett of Farmington and Lora Jean Hall of Festus, and one brother Larry Charles (Clara) Dixon of Jackson.

Patsy graduated from Patton High School in 1957, and graduated from cosmetology school in Jackson. On July 30, 1960 she married Dewel David Sharrock of Patton. They lived happily for almost 60 years on their farm in Patton, gardening, farming, and ranching. Dewel passed away December 21, 2022. 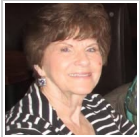
