Ray Lynn Yeargain, 86, of Saint Charles, Missouri died Sunday, June 29, 2025 at Parc Provence in Creve Coeur, MO.

He was born May 22, 1939 in Farmington, MO to the late Glenwood Yeargain Sr. and Lavinia Krewson. He married Louella Ellis on August 22, 1964 at Patton, MO, and they celebrated their 61st wedding anniversary last year.

Ray graduated from Farmington High School, and then received a Bachelors Degree from Murray State and a Masters Degree from SIU-C in Education. He began his career teaching Industrial Arts in the Hazelwood School District, and served as various principals of Hazelwood high schools, retiring in the 90's. Upon his retirement, Ray owned a successful irrigation company in St. Charles and enjoyed chatting with his customers more than the sprinkler systems. Ray was very instrumental in helping Louella to grow her antique button collection. Ray was a devoted husband, father, grandfather and great-grandfather.

Survivors include his wife Louella, daughter Susan (Mark) MacDonald of Newton, MA, (5) grandchildren, Trey Swick (Megan), Max Yeargain, Jack, Marisa and Gavin MacDonald and two great-grandchildren Cameron and Blaine Swick.
