Billy had a big heart and wanted to save all the island animals. He enjoyed boating, volleyball on the beach, scuba diving, and playing pickle ball.

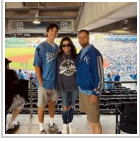
Left to cherish his memory is his one sister, Jenny James of Jackson, MO.
